Action Taken at last MANA meeting, November 1, 2004

Motion to support the City of Boulder's recommended changes to the occupancy ordinance:

Vice President Steve Clason requested a motion, which was not on the planned agenda, to support the recommended changes to the occupancy ordinance. It would read: "Martin Acres Neighborhood Association favors adoption of the proposed ordinance changes extending the occupancy benefit, now restricted to married couples, to couples registered in the Boulder Domestic Partners Registry providing these two provisions of the proposed changes are maintained: 1. that the occupancy benefit be only extended to **registered** partners who cannot by law marry; 2. that the Domestic Partner Registry be maintained as a **public document**." The Vote on the above resulted in 4 yea and 2 abstained (Betty Schweikert and Christiane Sammoury). Christiane's rejection was based on the fact that such recognition would officially recognize the domestic partners therefore it would imply that the whole community at Martin Acres under the voice of the President and/or Vice President would recognize them. The vote ended up in 4 votes for 12 steering committee memmers.
