Martin Acres Neighborhood RTD Eco Pass

Due to RTD's strict criteria regarding Neighborhood Eco Passes, approximately 26 blocks in the Martin Acres Neighborhood did not qualify for a pass.

Neighborhood residents and Eco Pass coordinators are interested in finding out why these 26 blocks did not qualify. More importantly, what changes should RTD make to its Neighborhood Eco Pass program? As of now, there is a minimum cost of \$5,000.00 for a neighborhood to qualify as an Eco Pass District. Each block of participating houses MUST be contiguous with other participating blocks.

Pass prices are based on route access, census data, percentages of CU students, seniors, and projected business pass holders in the area. The prices are configured to be "revenue neutral" so that RTD neither makes nor loses money regardless of the program's success or failure. From this research it was determined that Martin Acres' costs would be \$128.04 per house.

Information for RTD: The Number of Households Which Subsidized Others Of those 312 households (excluding all vacant homes) that qualified for the Neighborhood Eco Pass, 215 households did not contribute money to the Pass program. In other words, approximately 31% of the qualifying households subsidized the rest.

The Percentage of Households Which Did Not Qualify Of the 1,280 households which make up Martin Acres, only 312 households qualified for the Neighborhood Eco Pass. Therefore, almost 76% of Martin Acres was not able to purchase the discounted pass.

The Percentage of Households Which Already Have Passes Of the 312 households that qualified for the Eco Pass most were CU Student households.
