MANA MEETING

At our May meeting we discussed US 36 traffic noise and the Compatibility Studies regarding modifying your house. Several people in Martin Acres are concerned that the City of Boulder may unnecessarily restrict how large they can make their homes. Many people enjoy improving their real estate for their own use or to improve property values.

I have participated in the study groups for this and recognize the problem and do not believe the City is going to pass new rules without more consideration.

Mayor Matt Appelbaum, who attended our meeting, wants to have a City wide set of rules. I think we may have to have a special set of rules for our neighborhood.

One caution that I have is that as larger homes are built we will end up having larger rental houses and suffer the effects from additional cars and activities.

We also had the local CDOT representative, Bob Garcia, along with three associates and a Traffic Engineer at the meeting. State Representative, Claire Levy from South Boulder arranged this meeting. Folks from Frasier Meadows and Martin Acres were there to express their concerns. We wanted to know why the speed limit, now set at 65 mph on US 36 between Baseline and Table Mesa, couldn't be lowered to at least 55 to cut down on the road noise. CDOT sets the speed limits on State highways based on how fast people drive, without

consideration for the secondary effects to a neighborhood. There was also a great deal of concern from residents about the safety of 65 mph traffic slowing down suddenly to 35 as it enters 28th St. Moorhead residents wanted to know if CDOT would consider installing a sound wall behind their properties. CDOT explained that they have no funds until 2035 for that consideration.

I think it will take a lot of political action from the City of Boulder and at the State level to change how CDOT does business.

FREE

The Center for Resource Conservation (CRC) offers free irrigation system inspections to increase sprinkler system efficiency and promote proper watering practice. This inspection includes a visual to pinpoint any problems, tests to measure precipitation, tests to determine how evenly the water covers the intended area and a soil sample to find root depth and soil type. Later you will receive a customized watering schedule and how to make your system more effective and efficient.

The inspection takes about 2 hours and is available from June until August. Call 303/999-3820 ext. 217 to make an appointment or go to conservationcenter.org
