Neighborhood Retail Spotlight: Sweet Ruckus, Table Mesa Shopping Center

It's the pleasure of the VOICE to be able to disseminate information on some of the interesting and unique businesses cropping up in our neck of the woods. In 2017 South Boulder gained a whimsical new gift shop in the Table Mesa shopping center, Sweet Ruckus. Owner Tania Petrulis grew up in Colorado and lived most of her life here, including—on and off—stints in South Boulder. Tania says she wanted to open a retail store because South Boulder hasn't had anything like this in quite a while. Petrulis said she didn't want to open "just anywhere—and certainly not downtown."

Previous to Sweet Ruckus, Petrulis ran a gift business for a couple of years. This unique bit of neighborhood-serving retail was, Petrulis says, what South Boulder was lacking and asking for—with no similar store anywhere south of Arapahoe. Sweet Ruckus features a wide variety of women's accessories, baby gifts, bed and bath items, jewelry, paper goods and a great selection of cards and chocolates.

So far, Petrulis says "business is going well." While the neighborhoods surrounding are still discovering Sweet Ruckus, Petrulis says "It's exciting to feel support and interest from the neighborhoods. People seem really happy to have a business like ours on this side of town."

When asked what the key to such a positive reception might be, Petrulis says, "The experience is the key. We have a shop that smells good, feels good, where the items are visually pleasing. We have special gifts from the heart. We want to be a part of the community, of the neighborhood. "

Sweet Ruckus is on the north side of the Table Mesa Shopping Center, below Shuttles, Spindles and Skeins.

WHAT'S HAPPENING AT BASEMAR?

First Whole Foods, then Beau Joe's, Everyone's Hair and most recently The Egg and I—four businesses have shuttered their Basemar locations in the past 12 months. With a strong dedication towards neighborhood-serving retail and a desire to support thriving, walk able, 15 minute neighborhoods, many Martin Acres residents, along with lower Chautauqua and other South Boulder neighbors are asking, "What is going on at Basemar?"

Local news coverage of the closings seemed to offer little information aside from the implication of steeply rising rents, and in the case of Whole Foods, (recently purchased by Amazon), and a move away from brick and mortar locations in support of e-commerce.

One thing is clear, however, the options to walk or bike to various services in South Boulder is suffering. If a walkable environment and neighborhood serving retail are important to you, we encourage you to put your money where your mouth is, as they say, and support the services and shops in the centers surrounding our neighborhood at Basemar, Table Mesa, and Tantra area, to name a few. Martin Acres residents are lucky enough to be near Baseline, Broadway and Table Mesa Drive – all streets that could host walkable and bike-able retail. However, if we don't support them this blessing will become a curse, forcing neighbors into increasingly difficult drives to central Boulder in search of retail and others services.

One unanswered question is: Is there a vision for Basemar?
